Materials covered include Wood / Metal / Plastic and Graphic Design They will also cover the theory needed to complete the written exam at the end of Y11.

Students then specialise in one area for their final assessment.

Assessment

Unit 1: Examination = 2 hours (50% of total marks) Material theory, Maths, Science

<u>Unit 2:</u> Controlled Assessment = A single design and make activity
