I am proud of the progress I have made so far in learning British Sign Language. It is a language I have always wanted to learn, and my parents at home are having fun learning it with me.

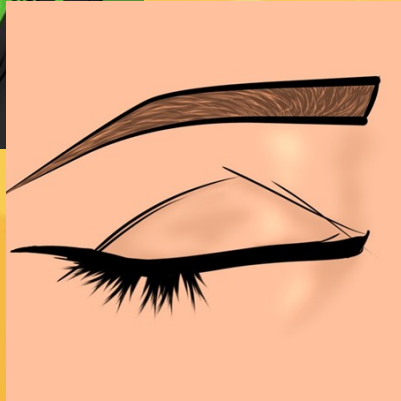
I'm proud of the fish I caught when I went fishing with my dad. It was very heavy, weighing at 13.8lbs. My picture was in a fishing magazine!
