Units of study

Unit 1

Human Lifespan Development

Learners will explore physical, intellectual, emotional and social development across the human lifespan. They will also study the different factors that affect human development and the effects of ageing.

The examination will be 1 hour and 30 minutes in length.

Unit 2

Working in Health and Social care

Learners will explore the needs of different service users, the roles and responsibilities of workers and working practices within the health and social care sector.

Unit 5

Meeting Individual Care and Support Needs

Learners will explore the principles, skills and values that underpin care. They will examine ethical issues linked to providing care and the principles involved in overcoming challenges. Learners will also investigate the roles of professionals and how they work together.
