Dear Parent/Carer of year 9 or year 10 pupil.

As you may know, the school has received a tuition grant from the government to supplement students learning in school. We have been spending this grant on in school tutoring, providing places at a local provider (Kip McGrath based in Heanor) and offering pupils in this year's Year 11 the opportunity to have small group private tutoring in either English or Mathematics.

The small group private tutoring has been effective in accelerating the progress of students who have taken part in the programme. The feedback from the students who have completed the small group private tutoring has been very positive and they have not only enjoyed their lessons but realised the benefits of taking part in such sessions. We are therefore extending the opportunity to take part in this programme to all students in next year's Year 10 and Year 11 initially.

The programme is provided by [mytutor.co.uk](http://mytutor.co.uk). Please feel free to visit their website for more detailed information about the sessions they offer. Students will have the opportunity to choose either English, Maths or Science. It will be most beneficial to choose the subject that they feel they need the most help in making progress based on tests, assessment and mock examination feedback. They will have 15 x 1 hour sessions with their tutor on the same night every week. This session will be at either 4.30pm or 6 pm. When committing to the programme it is expected that students attend every session. Students will be placed with three students of similar ability from Aldercar High School. It is expected that these sessions will begin in October and last for 15 school weeks.

There will also be the opportunity for you to express your child's interest in also attending Kip McGrath for intensive work and assessment for GCSE English and Maths although these places will be allocated on the greatest needs basis and are limited due to the cost of such a programme. The deadline for completion of the form is 20th July 2022.
