Course Structure	<p><b>Personal Portfolio:</b> Internally set projects and themes that will cover a range of techniques and processes for Vocational qualifications.</p> <p><b>Externally Set Assignment :</b> 10 hour practical assessment</p> <p>The work they produce will be presented at an exhibition at the end of the course (<b>60%</b> of the final grade). The last module will consist of the work set by the Examination Board, and the pupils will exhibit this along with their coursework (<b>40%</b> of the final grade). These are provisional percentages as based on current knowledge.</p>
