#### **Derbyshire Domestic Abuse Support Services**

Changes is a voluntary programme assisting those concerned they might be hurting, scaring, or controlling their partner and want help making changes



#### Do you want to make changes?

Relationships can be challenging and make us feel vulnerable

Being intimate with someone means getting close enough them to do things they do not want to do. to get hurt. This means our emotions feel stronger than they do with other people: we can get frustrated, feel jealous and worry when things aren't working how we

We sometimes find ourselves behaving in ways which hurt or scare the people around us, and make us feel bad about ourselves.

You do not have the right to hurt or scare your partner (or ex-partner), call them names, intimidate them or force

You do not have the right to choose who they can or

But it's never too late to start making changes.

Do you want to change your behaviour? We can help you to start to make positive changes.

#### This service is completely free of charge and tailored to meet individual needs.

We provide individual assessments, and group-work sessions which help people to understand relationship difficulties, to take responsibility for abusive behaviour, and to make positive changes for themselves, their (ex) partners, and their children (if they have any).

#### Eligibility Criteria:

Males, aged 18 years or over who are not currently involved in any Criminal proceedings, and not actively involved in Private Family Law proceedings, or have been within the previous 12 months.

Using violent and/or abusive behaviour towards their partner or ex-partner and identified as Low or Medium risk Ready and willing to learn and take accountability for their actions.

If any mental health needs/concerns, or any drug/substance/alcohol misuse have been identified which may impact on service provision, the client must be actively seeking/receiving support for this in order to be accepted onto the program.

#### Professional Referrals:

If you suspect or know that someone you are working with is mistreating their partner, please get in touch. We can help them make positive changes in their life so they stop their abusive behaviour towards others. We also provide practical 1-2-1 support to survivors who are partners/ex-partners of those who are participating in the Changes programme

- ✓ Promote respectful relationships

The Changes project is managed and delivered by a consortium of three organisations, who deliver intervention, guidance and support to those individuals referred to the project.

The consortium is made up of three specialist domestic abuse support providers: The Elm Foundation, Crossroads Derbyshire and Derbyshire WISH Domestic Abuse Services and together the consortium provides cover throughout Derbyshire.





### Showcase of the Month

#### **Healthy Start NHS Scheme**

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
- fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding

vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old



#### **Healthy Start: How to apply**

If you get Universal Credit, you can apply online if:

- you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have at least one child under 4 years old
- your family's monthly 'take-home pay' (also called 'earned income') is £408 or less from employment

If you get Child Tax Credit, you may be eligible for Healthy Start if:

- your family's annual income is £16,190 or less
- you do not get Working Tax Credit
- Most people who get Child Tax Credit can apply online. You can apply online if you're either:
- more than 10 weeks pregnant and have children under the age of 4
- not pregnant but have children under the age of 4

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant and have other children who are all aged 4 or older, you'll need to apply by email or phone.

To apply online, you'll need your:

- name
- address
- date of birth
- National Insurance number
- baby's due date (if you're pregnant)
- benefit award letter if you're over 18 make sure you enter the exact details shown on your benefit award letter
