
Deaf Mosaic

Photography Exhibition at Artcore Gallery



On Wednesday 16th October, deaf pupils visited the Deaf Mosaic photography exhibition at Artcore Gallery in Derby. The exhibition was made by a deaf artist called Stephen Liffe and featured photographs of deaf people who all had very different careers. The message of the exhibition was that **deaf people can do anything they want to,** if they have the right support.



Pupils loved this exhibition and found it incredibly inspiring. They enjoyed looking at all of the different portraits and learning their stories. Each portrait also had a description underneath, alongside a QR code which led to a video description in BSL.





Pupils also participated in a clay workshop with Derbyshire based ceramicist Kathryn Borg. Kathryn does not use a potters wheel like other ceramicists, but instead moulds all of her clay manually.

Pupils learned techniques for working with clay and made a clay tile of their initial. We had lots of fun but got very messy! We really enjoyed the session and learned a lot.
